Saxton B. Little Free Library Expands Patron Services with the VERSO® Integrated Library System

Challenge:

The Columbia Free Library opened in 1883 and became the Saxton B. Little Free Library in 1903. This public library houses a collection of nearly 40,000 items and serves a population of over 5,000 in Columbia, Connecticut. Over the past ten years the library has worked hard to achieve its goals of better serving the evolving needs of its patrons and leveraging the latest advancements in technology to continually modernize and streamline its operations.

In the early 1990s the Saxton B. Little Free Library began exploring its options to replace its manual circulation, lending and borrowing processes. The library staff reviewed various ILS products on the market, however, they quickly realized that many of the available library automation solutions were tailored for larger lending establishments with substantial IT budgets and departmental resources.

The small, public library needed a library automation partner that could help it keep pace with technology while keeping an eye on its budgetary restrictions.

Solution:

In 1995, after carefully evaluating several leading library management products, Saxton B. Little selected VERSO®. It proved to be an ideal solution for the library as it was designed to handle a library's automation needs while also addressing limited financial and IT resources. The system's easy-to-use interface and extensive features allowed the library staff to recognize an immediate improvement in their daily operations, while not being too complex to learn and use.

The staff is also able to access and utilize a variety of customizable reports and a comprehensive statistics package online and in real-time. Deployed on a SaaS basis, the Saxon B. Little Free Library's system requires no client software to load or maintain.
